

"Recovery and Transformation: Post-Pandemic Life from Economic, Business, Tourism, and Educational Perspectives"

The Covid-19 pandemic has led to recession and decreased productivity in all sectors. We noticed 4 (four) main sectors experiencing the most significant impact of the pandemic: economy, business, tourism, and education. For example, the pandemic has caused Indonesia's first recession in the last 22 years, creating a challenging environment for the business to expand and survive. The national tourism sector has also faced severe problems due to travel restrictions. In addition, educational processes have changed completely, where teachers and students had to switch to a new system of virtual learning. As a result, approximately 3.5 million people would lose their jobs, while many others would be affected by the pandemic.

The conference aims to reach a global consensus on multi-perspective approaches, supported by the commitment and political will of countries, to make post-pandemic recovery efforts possible. This also aims to build a solid and sustainable foundation for life after the Covid-19 pandemic.

The conference focuses on the 4 (four) primary sectors, including the economy, business, tourism, and education, affected by the Covid-19 pandemic and the recovery efforts. This conference will open up chances to promote and strengthen the perspectives of the academics related to the policy that the private and public sectors can follow.


